Monkfield Medical Practice is a General Practice Partnership open to all patients living within our Practice boundary of Cambourne. Cambourne is a new town which continues to grow; currently we have a practice population of approximately 13,000. Our patient demographic mainly comprises of families with young children.

We are a Personal Medical Service (PMS) Practice offering Primary care services for the diagnosis and prevention of disease. We help patients to manage their health and prevent illness. Our team assess, diagnose, treat and manage illness. They carry out screening for some diseases and promote general health and wellbeing. Our team act as a patient's advocate, supporting and representing a patient's best interests to ensure they receive the best and most appropriate health and/or social care. Our team also provide the link to further health services and work closely with



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other healthcare colleagues. They may also arrange hospital admissions and referrals to other services and specialists and they link with secondary and community services about patient care, taking advice and sharing information where needed. We work collaboratively with our PCN to meet our community's needs and we aim to be an active contributor to our community. We deliver research studies to provide the latest developments in healthcare within an ethical framework, and we provide non-NHS services to respond to demand. We provide educational opportunities to medical students and allied health professionals, and are in the process of joining the Cambridge VTS GP training scheme.
